"Your stress therapy proved invaluable for us recently. We had taken Commet to a 4H event.. where Commet had gotten his halter half way off his head in the trailer and had a few little cuts on his nose. We got the halter adjusted and looked around to see what could have cut him, and the only thing that we saw that it could have been was if the escape door had been open, but it wasn't..... But when we shut the escape door, we heard all this banging and rattling, and we opened the door back up and Commet had freaked out and jumped across the chest bar. (We think the strong winds may have blown through the trailer while we were at lunch and pushed the escape door open and it had been scaring him while we were gone.... and then when we closed the door, it brought back all the scariness that happened to him while we were gone and he freaked).

He was trapped with his neck pressed up on the front of the trailer and his head twisted towards the escape door and his belly being compressed by the chest bar. Ashlin started patting him and talking to him, and I started doing stress therapy.... tapping his chest and occasionally his knees (which were the only parts of the body I could reach because of the trailer configuration), while our trainer spent 20 minutes hammering up the pin that held the chest bar to try to free the chest bar so it would fall down and Commet wouldn't be hung across the bar. There was a lot of loud noise which would have normally terrified him and he could of possibly gotten seriously hurt, but he remained remarkably calm and we were finally able to free him with only a few minor abrasions on the back of his legs and no internal injuries.

But the true testament to your therapy, is that despite this horrific experience, Commet walked right back on the trailer 3 days later when he had to take him somewhere else. Without your therapy, I bet we would have had a major ordeal getting him back on. So thanks once again for your wonderful therapy."
